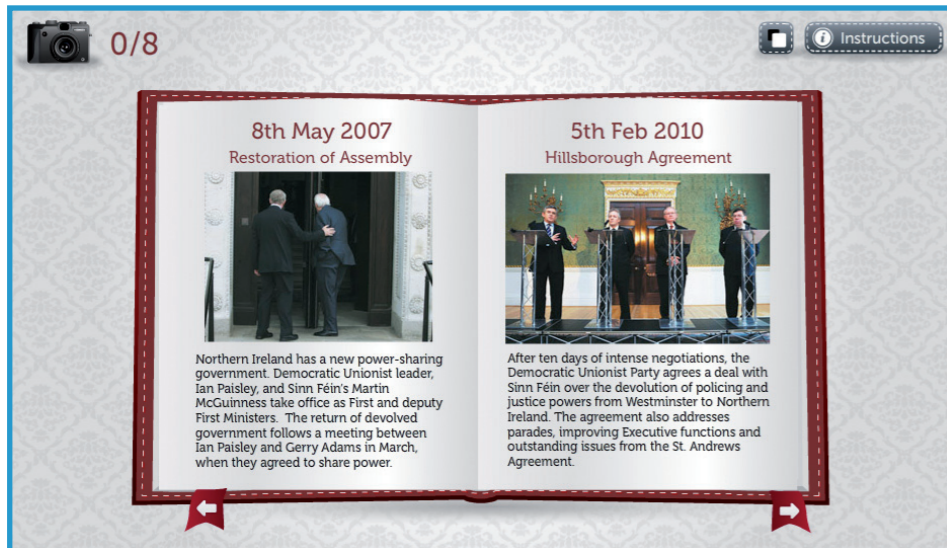

Students should be able to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of:

- the government of Northern Ireland since 1994 including political arrangements such as direct rule and devolution of power to the Northern Ireland Assembly.



Online Activity

The Snapshots of Devolution book presents photographs and information about some of the key events in the devolution process. The students use the camera to record each event and recall the sequence by pinning the photographs up in the correct order when they reach the darkroom.



How to Use the Multimedia

Use this resource to introduce some of the major events in the devolution of power to the Northern Ireland Assembly. The memory challenge can also be a fun and interactive way to revise.

Click on:

- the arrow tabs to turn the pages of the book; and
- the photographs to take a snapshot with your camera.

As you take a picture, read the text to help memorise that event. You will be taken to the darkroom after all the photographs are snapped.

Click:

- then drag your photograph to drop it into sequence on the line;
- the history book if you need help remembering the order of events; and

- the Check Results button to see how you've done!

The Check Results button will appear when all the photographs are in place.
