
UK General Election 2019

Change in NI representation in Westminster:

- DUP: 8 (-2)
- Sinn Fein: 7 (-)
- SDLP: 2 (+2)
- Alliance: 1 (+1)

NI vote share change since 2017

After 18 of 18 seats
